A visit in my wheelchair






For a simple check-up, I can stay in my wheelchair.




For treatment, I can stay in my wheelchair:

if my chair tilts backwards with a headrest, or




if the dentist has a machine to tilt my chair backwards.




This machine is only found in specialist centres.

The dentist lowers the chair.




I change seats.




I can ask for help.
